Improving your child's sleep will improve your child's grades

Children who do well in school consistently get a good night's sleep. Sleep gives children energy, focus, and the ability to recall information as well as problem solve. School success requires children to manage their emotions and behavior, both of which require reliable healthy sleep. Kids who are sleepy have problems concentrating and staying awake in class. Sleepiness can even cause their grades to go down. Children ages 3-5 should get 11-13 hours of sleep each night. Children ages 6-13 should get 9-11 hours of sleep each night. Here are some suggestions on how your child can get more sleep. Stress the importance of sleep in your home. Control your child's screen time before bed. Keep TV's, phones and video games out of your child's bedroom. Turn off smartphones, tablets and other screens about 1 hour before bedtime. Stick to a bedtime routine that includes time for your children to relax so that their minds and bodies will know it's time for bed. Be consistent-even on weekends.
