








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## Fruits of our Fall Harvest

The Montclair Community Farms continues to teach and work with our

students in the Robert L. Craig School Community Garden during the afterschool program.

According to Satoni Zaccaro, Farm Manager at Montclair Community Farms, the students discussed composting, what it is, and the importance of it in the garden. The students took a look at some compost that has broken down and went through it to see if they could find- bugs, remnants of eggshells, broken down fruit, leaves, etc. They even spotted things that don't belong in compost, like plastic.


Afterwards, the students cleared beds, added the new compost into the beds in order to "replenish" the soil so the new plants will have food to grow nice and strong. The students planted some lettuce, and then they harvested some tomatoes, peppers, collard greens and picked some flowers. Joining Zaccaro and the students this fall was After School Program Counselor Randy Petruzzella.

T he Guitar Club is off to a great start. Under the direction of Robert L.


