### Moonachie Families & Friends -

As summer comes to a close, I know everyone is anxious for the start of the school year! We are just about ready to welcome our students and families back to our great school! The school looks amazing, thanks to our wonderful custodial staff! Our fabulous teachers have begun to set up their learning spaces! Our office staff are finalizing schedules, bussing, curriculum, procedures, registrations, medical records, calendars of events, and responding to all of the questions and concerns you may have.

Most importantly, we are all excited for what (we hope) will be our first un-interrupted school year since 2018-2019.

Please read this update carefully, as it pertains a lot of important information.

### **Entrance Times & Procedures**

All drop offs will occur via the Gymnasium entrance again this year (same as last year), beginning at 8:10am. Students will report directly to homeroom for individualized tutoring and/or provided extra time to complete projects and assignments. A couple of points during drop off:

- Please do not pass on the left while in the horseshoe. We will continue to utilize cones to create onelane of traffic.
- Please make sure your child(ren) exit via the sidewalk side of your car.
- We will NOT be utilizing MyMedBot. Students will directly enter the building.
- We need to keep traffic moving. Do NOT leave your vehicle unattended in the horseshoe.
- Drop off will conclude at 8:45am. If you drop off after 8:45am, your child must enter through the main entrance. Homeroom begins promptly at 8:50am. If your child arrives to homeroom after 8:50am, he/she will be marked tardy.

#### **Dismissal Times & Procedures**

Dismissal times & procedures are changing this year. Please read carefully & let us know if you have any questions:

- Prek ONLY: Car & Walker Pick Up will be between 2:45pm-2:55pm. (1 Session Day: 12:40-12:50pm)
- Grades K 8: Car & Walker Pick up will be between 3:00pm 3:15pm. (1 Session Day: 12:50-1:00pm)
  - For Security purposes, K-8 families are NOT permitted to arrive before 3:00pm. If there is an emergency, we need to be able to get first responders to the school without a traffic delay. Therefore, you may no longer arrive before 3:00pm, park in the horseshoe and wait for dismissal. Any cars arriving before 3:00pm, will be asked to leave.
  - To accommodate this change, we have extended the dismissal period to 3:15pm.
  - We will utilize the same procedure as last year of calling children individually as your car arrives.
  - Do NOT leave your car unattended in the horseshoe. Your child will come to your car.

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- If you have a PREK student <u>and</u> a student in another grade level, you will pick up all children between 3:00-3:15pm.
- Do NOT pass the 'Do Not Enter' gate along the parking side of the road. This is a one-way. You must go around the horseshoe to exit.
- Please Do NOT block the entrance/exit driveway near the playground.
- Please be patient during the first days of school as we learn new families and vehicles.

### **First Day of School**

The First Day of School is for celebration, excitement, and joy! Please review the following information so we can all celebrate the First Day of School:

- You CANNOT leave your car unattended in the horseshoe.
- No parents/guardians are permitted to enter the building, for any reason.
- If you are taking pictures, please be mindful of how long you are present as others behind you wish for the same opportunity.
- Students in grades PK-4 will report directly to the Gymnasium and will meet their class.
- Students in grades 5-8 will report directly to the Cafeteria and will meet their class.
- It makes everything run more efficiently if your student knows the name of his/her homeroom teacher. Please review this with your child before coming to school.

## **Breakfast & Lunch Ordering**

The Federal Government did not renew the COVID benefit of free breakfast and lunch for all students. Therefore, we must go back to families pre-ordering and paying for meals via our Food Service Coordinator, Ms. Lucrezia Maurin. We encourage all families to fill out the Free & Reduced Food Application (information below) to see if your family qualifies for this benefit. Ms. Maurin will be sending out information on September ordering shortly.

- Breakfast (daily) 8:10 8:40am
  - Upon arrival to school, all students will report directly to homeroom for tutoring and extra time on assignments/projects/homework. Homeroom begins promptly at 8:50am.
  - If your student requires breakfast, please make sure he/she knows! Your child will go to the cafeteria, pick-up their breakfast, and then report to homeroom. For grades K-2, please also inform your teacher so we can ensure each student who needs breakfast, gets it.

  - o Grades K-4: 12:20pm 1:05pm

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### **COVID Protocols Update**

NJDOH has not provided schools an update since July 8<sup>th</sup>. As a result, we must follow this guidance. If we receive updated guidance before school starts, we will provide the community an additional update.

- No individual case-by-case contact tracing.
- No stationary class cohorts. Students will travel for classes. (Elementary students will travel for Specialists; Middle School students will travel for every class)
- Masks remain optional.
- Quarantines are recommended for unvaccinated students where a member in the household has tested positive (Remote learning will be activated)
- If a Student Tests Positive for COVID-19
  - Report positive test to Nurse Gallo
  - Remain home for days 0-5 (Remote Learning will be available), return to School for days 6-10 with a mask.
- Provide a weekly update on positive cases within the school.
- We will continue to provide increased sanitation stations at entrance, in classrooms, bathrooms, and the cafeteria.
- We will continue our increased ventilation protocols.
- Parents are asked to monitor your child at home. Please keep him/her home if her/she is ill.

Teachers will work with students on how to organize themselves for success each day.

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## **NJSLA & Start Strong Update**

As of this writing we have not received the NJSLA State Assessment results from May for grades 3-8 in ELA, Math, & Science.

The State of NJ is still requiring all districts to administer the State Assessment: Start Strong before September 30<sup>th</sup>. This will be administered to grades 4-8 in ELA & Math, as well as Grade 6 in Science. Parents will receive an assessment schedule shortly.

You will also be provided the procedure to opt-out your child from these standards, should you choose. None of these standards will be addressed until the Spring of 2023, well after these collaborative events and the opt-out process has taken place. If you are a parent in Grades 2, 5, & 8 – We will communicate directly with you on the schedule of these events. We welcome and look forward to your collaboration and feedback.
