Community Update #3

Moonachie Families and Friends -

I hope this message finds you and your students well, although probably exhausted following the completion of our first week of school. We had such a wonderful week of smiles, wonder, laughter, and sharing of summer adventures. While there were also plenty of tears and anxiety by parents, students, and staff alike, everyone demonstrated positivity and resilience! Now, we can all settle into our new routines!

A couple of points to close out our week that need addressing or reminding.

Dismissal – Car Line & Walkers Update

First, I appreciate everyone's patience this week while we work though some new procedures. As I have shared in previous community updates, for security reasons we must keep the front horseshoe clear of parked cars until we are ready to dismiss. As you all know, we do not have extra parking spots either. We all must follow dismissal procedures to ensure not only a smooth and quick dismissal, but most importantly, a safe dismissal and campus. If we <u>ALL</u> follow these points, wait times and the line length will dramatically decrease.

- 1) ONLY PRE-K families are permitted to arrive at 2:45. This allows for our youngest students, who require car seats, extra time to safely load. (12:40 on half-days)
- 2) Grades K-5 cars may begin at 3:00pm. <u>Always</u> pull all the way up. <u>Stay</u> in your car. <u>Load</u> from the right side. <u>Move</u> as quickly as possible. (12:50 on half-days)
- 3) Grades 6-8 will <u>NOT</u> be called. If you are picking up a Middle School student, arrive after 3:10pm. Middle School students are in class until 3:05 and will not be dismissed early. Between 3:05-3:10, students are going to their lockers and securing their laptops. There is no reason to arrive before 3:10. If you are waiting for a MS student, please pull out of the car lane and wait on the opposite side. (1:00 on half-days)
- 4) If you have students in multiple grades PK-5, please arrive during the 3:00-3:10pm time frame for all students.
- 5) If you arrive before your assigned time, you will be asked to leave and come back.
- 6) Do not worry about, "Being early so you're not late". We have plenty of staff to supervise the children.
- 7) Walkers will be called first. If you are walking, you may arrive at any time and wait on the side walk for dismissal to begin at 3:00.

Early Dismissals - **NEW**

2:30pm will be the cut off for early dismissals. No early dismissals will be permitted after 2:30. If your family experiences an emergency requiring pickup between 2:30-3:00, please call the main office first.

Reminder: Cars should never be left unattended. The entrance doors close at 8:50am. If you arrive after 8:50, your student must enter through the main entrance and the student will be marked late.
