## How to Convert

## Multiply <br> BIG unit --- small unit

TON - pound
POUND - ounce

Divide
small unit --- BIG unit

pound - TON<br>ounce - POUND

## Conversions

$\mathrm{Oz}=$ ounce

$$
\begin{gathered}
\mathrm{lb}=\text { pound } \\
1 \mathrm{lb}=16 \mathrm{oz} \\
1 \mathrm{~T}=2,000 \mathrm{lbs}
\end{gathered}
$$

$$
\mathrm{T}=\text { ton }
$$

| Example: A skateboard weighs 4 pounds. How many ounces does it |
| :--- |
| weigh? |


| $1 \mathrm{lb}=16 \mathrm{oz}$ | For every pound there are 16 ounces. |
| :--- | :--- |
| $4 \mathrm{lbs}=64$ ozs | So, multiply $4 \times 16=64$ ounces. |

Example: If a shark weighs 4,000 pounds, how many tons does it weigh?
$1 \mathrm{~T}=2,000 \mathrm{lb} \quad$ For every ton, there are 2,000 pounds.
